- B. Academic essay

Timetable – guidelines and important dates

An extended abstract of 1000 words, a list of keywords (4-8), a title, subtitles, name of author and email address to corresponding author should be sent (by email) to the organizing committee no later than 25 March 2019. Authors with accepted abstracts will be asked to submit a *full paper* no later than 25 August. The conference paper should be about 8000 words, excluding abstract, references and figures. Further guidelines will later be sent to scholars whose abstracts have been approved.
